Executive Session

Date: January 19, 2021

An executive session of the Board of Trustees of the Greenwood Community School Corporation was called to order by Mr. Mike Metzger at 5:02 P.M. in the Administration Building of the Greenwood Community School Corporation.

Persons present: Mr. Mike Metzger, Mr. Brian Ford, Mr. Chris Zaborowsky and Mr. Jack Napier. Mrs. Deanna Burton was present via a Zoom call. A quorum was met.

The following topics were discussed:

- ___ 1. Where authorized by federal or state statute. See I.C. 5-14-1.5-6.1(b)(1).
- ___ 2. For discussion of strategy with respect to any of the following:
 - A. collective bargaining;
 - B. initiation of litigation or litigation that is either pending or has been threatened specifically in writing;
 - C. the implementation of security systems;
 - D. the purchase or lease of real property by the governing body up to the time a contract or option to purchase or lease is executed by the parties;
 - E. school consolidation.
- ___ 3. For discussion of the assessment, design, and implementation of school safety and security measures, plans, and systems.
- ___ 4. To receive information about and interview prospective employees.
- ___ 5. With respect to any individual over whom the governing body has jurisdiction, to receive information concerning the individual's misconduct; and to discuss, before a determination, the individual's status as an employee, a student, or an independent contractor who is a physician or a school bus driver. See I.C. 5-14-1.5-6.1(b)(6).
- ___ 6. For discussion of records classified as confidential by state or federal statute. See I.C. 5-14-1.5-6.1(b)(7).
- ___ 7. To discuss before a placement decision an individual student's abilities, past performance, behavior, and needs.
- ___ 8. To discuss a job performance evaluation of individual employees. This subdivision does not apply to a discussion of the salary, compensation, or benefits of employees during a budget process.
- ___ 9. When considering the appointment of a public official to do the following:
 - A. develop a list of prospective applicants;
 - B. consider applications;
 - C. make one (1) initial exclusion of applicants from further consideration.
- ___ 10. To train school board members with an outside consultant about the performance of the role of the members as public officials.




The Board certifies that no subject matter was discussed in this Executive Session other than the subject matter specified in the public notice.
